Sidonia Reiss, 1882-1970, well known to many "older" Adlerians, both in Europe and in New York - died September 8, 1970, in Neustadt (Hesse) in a Home for Elder Jewish (former Refugee) Persons. She was a personal student of Alfred Adler since about 1918; worked for many years in Berlin, as successful individual therapist and also in the Consultation Centers. In the early 1930's she went to Holland, working closely with our Dutch *Individual Psychology* friends. During the Nazi occupation she was hidden and protected in the "underground." She published *Mental Adjustment* (1948) in London, which still deserves reading as an excellent Adlerian contribution. She was a member of the American Society of Adlerian Psychology since 1953. In 1969, she wrote reminiscences about Adler for a Centenary collection.
